On mid-March, the DRIVES project progresses to an important milestone for collecting evidence from the automotive sector on their expectations to satisfy the short- and medium-term skills needs.

Aiming at delivering automotive sector-specific solutions under the blueprint framework set by the European Commission in the European Skills Agenda, DRIVES consortium looks into bringing results driven and owned by the automotive sector stakeholders.

The DRIVES project is organising its first webinar to introduce the project strategy and its stakeholder's questionnaire. This initiative is part of DRIVES intelligence research effort, by which the consortium aims to provide analysis of the sector trends regarding skills and trainings, to the benefit of the automotive sector.
