HIGHLIGHTS

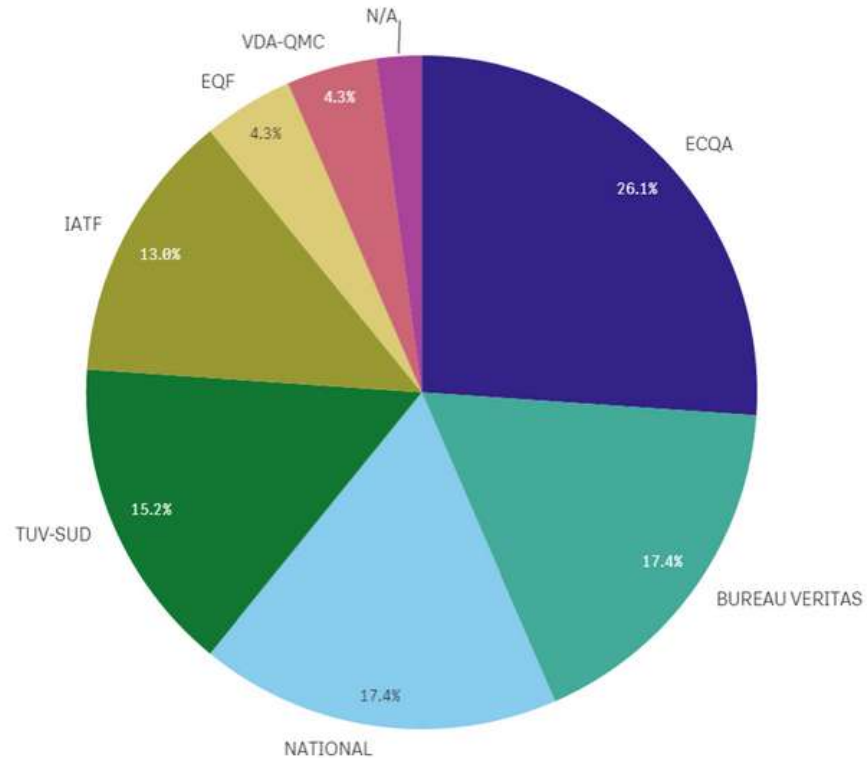
“ECQA” accounts for more than 25 % of all cited recognised standard and qualification frameworks , followed by “BUREAU VERITAS” (17.4 %)
