

HINGS TO WONX

- Competitors and production in non-EU markets will grow strongly whilst EU production may remain relatively flat. Retaining EU's global competitiveness depends on highly investing in the new and emerging areas.

- New expertise through R&D, stable access to (key) raw materials together with product standardization and technical harmonization need to be assured by the regulatory dialogue with the EU's main trading partners.


IIGHLIGHT


- Sectoral Industrial Associations stress the importance and urgency of access to raw materials across the sector.
