THINGS TO KNOW


- Job Roles associated to recognised drivers of change were categorised according to ESCO taxonomy (https://ec.europa.eu/esco/portal/occupation).

HIGHLIGHTS


- Within the 15 Job Roles featured, the top ones are typically automotive specific: 'Automotive Data Analyst', 'Powertrain Engineer' and 'Automotive Technician'. 'Innovation Manager' is the immediate non-automotive specific.
- Faithful to sector trends and concerns, SMEs list 'Advanced Material Engineer' first.
- Sales and marketing job roles are consigned a secondary position.
